This information is about cervical screening. This is sometimes called a smear test.



A meeting is being held to help women with learning disabilities understand more about cervical screening.



Dr Patel will talk about getting a smear test. This means checking for signs of cancer early. It helps stop cancer before it starts.

Remember, cervical screening is important for your health. It helps find problems early.



The test looks for changes in your cervix. Women have a cervix that is inside your body at the top of your vagina. You cannot see it.



Cervical screening test looks for a virus that can be in the cervix. For a very small number of women the virus can be serious.



Having a smear test can stop you getting cancer. Finding the cancer and getting treatment early can save thousands of lives every year.



It is your choice if you have the smear test or not.
